ANNOUNCEMENT

Please take notice we've had a change in snow removal procedures.

The City of Milford ordinance requires the Milford downtown business commercial district to remove snow, ice, and accumulations twelve (12) hours from the cessation of snowfall. In all other areas of the city twenty four (24) hours from the cessation of snowfall.

- **Who needs to remove snow, ice, and accumulations?**
 - Owners and occupants with businesses and properties bordering sidewalks
- **When to remove snow, ice, and accumulations?**
 - Snow and ice needs to be cleared from sidewalks in the downtown business commercial district within 12 hours after a snowfall and 24 hours for all other areas in the city.
- **Where to Shovel?**
 - Clear full width of the sidewalk. Salt and sand icy spots.
- **What happens If I Don't remove snow, ice, and accumulations?**
 - The City may do so and assess the costs, including a reasonable administration fee of \$25.00 against the property owner.
 - Property owners will also be guilty of a municipal infraction punishable by a fine of
 - \$100.00 First offense
 - \$150.00 Second offense
 - \$250.00 for any subsequent offense
- **What happens if I throw, push, or place snow/ice from private property onto a street or alley?**
 - You will be charged with a simple misdemeanor... UNLESS you are a property owner in the downtown business commercial district (*map on backside*) adjoining the following streets:
 - Highway 71 from 11th Street to 8th Street
 - 10th Street from N Avenue to P Avenue
 - 9th Street from N Avenue to P Avenue
 - Than you may place snow from these sidewalks into the street provided that:
 - From the face of the curb all snow shall be placed a minimum of 18" and not more than 36" into the street; and
 - All snow placed in the street from the above listed shall be placed within 12 hours of the time of declaration of a snow emergency by the Public Works Supervisor.
- **What happens if I push snow or ice across any portion of a street in a residential neighborhood?**
 - You will be charged with a simple misdemeanor
- **How can I get notifications when there is a snow emergency for Milford?**
