

RESOLUTION NO. 21-08

APPROVAL OF FY2022 MAXIMUM PROPERTY TAX DOLLARS

WHEREAS, the Council (“Council”) of the City of Milford, Dickinson County, Iowa (“City”) has considered the proposed FY2022 city maximum property tax dollars for the affected levy total (“proposal”);

WHEREAS, a notice concerning the proposed city maximum property tax dollars was published, in a newspaper of general circulation in Dickinson County, Iowa in accordance with applicable law, and posted on city website and/or social media accounts if applicable;

WHEREAS, a public hearing concerning said proposal was held on February 8th, 2021.

WHEREAS, the City Council, after considering all comments from City staff and the public present at its hearing, has determined it is in the best interest of the City and its citizens to proceed and approve said proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council that the maximum property tax dollars for the affected tax levies for FY2022 shall not exceed the following total:

Total maximum levy for affected property tax levies \$1,766,073



Councilmember Eckard offered the foregoing Resolution and moved for its adoption.


Councilmember Yungbluth seconded said Resolution and upon roll call the following vote was recorded.


Thereupon the Mayor declared the foregoing Resolution passed this 8th day of February, 2021.
