Discuss waiving fee on temporary signs that are community related that Emil Richter sets up.

Motion by Olsen, second by Hinshaw to waive the fee for temporary signs. The signs are for the benefit of the

to the meeting regarding the community related signs Emil Richter displays. Zoning Administrator Don Brinkley
provided some specifications for conforming to the ordinance, which will be listed on the sign permit application.
Mayor Anderson authorized Emil Richter to continue placing his signs with respect to keeping them out of the right-of-
way and displayed where there are no safety concerns during the permitting process. Sue Richter asked if fines would
be issued following authorization from Mayor Anderson to continue displaying the community related signs, and Mayor
Anderson responded there will be no fines issued. Sue Richter recommended if there will be changes made to the sign
ordinance to involve sign vendors.
