The Milford City Council met in special session September 9th, 2020 at 12:00 p.m. Noon in the Community Center Board Room.

Mayor Steve Anderson presided.

Motion by Gebhart second by Yungbluth to approve the agenda. All voting aye.

**ACTION & DISCUSSION ITEMS**

Possible Closed Session to Discuss Pending and Threatened Litigation. Iowa Code Chapter 21 including but not limited to Iowa Code Section 21.5(1)(c) To discuss strategy with counsel in matters that are presently in litigation or where litigation is imminent including to but not limited to a possible settlement. Action may be taken in open session

Motion by Gebhart second by Frederick to go into closed session to discuss strategy with counsel in matters that are presently in litigation and matters where litigation is imminent where its disclosure would be likely to prejudice or disadvantage the position of the City in that litigation. Roll call vote. Voting aye: Hinshaw, Gebhart, Frederick, Yungbluth and Eckard. Nay: None. Motion carried. Council went into closed session at 12:03 p.m.

**COMMENTS BY MAYOR COUNCIL, AND STAFF**

Deputy City Clerk Carrie Funk reviewed with council a draft letter she had put together for clean-up days and explained that after speaking with Jay Nieson with Waste Management we would need to provide a list to Waste Management a week prior to pickup of resident who wish to dispose of items. There was also a short discussion of charging a minimum \$25.00. This charge would be for residence wanting to get rid of items other than regular tagged items and put a limit of 2 yards per household. This drew concern from Councilman Hinshaw because he believes clean up days should be a free service. With that being said Reinsbach reached out to Jay with Waste Management to see if he could attend the September 14<sup>th</sup> council meeting for further discussion as council had questions. On a side note Mayor Anderson mentioned with the past insurance claims he had a conversation with a loss control specialist from ICAP. To help with this they are going to come in and do a valuation of policies and procedures primarily within our police department and then come up with a list of recommendations of what they think can be done to help alleviate some of the loss issues we have had.

With no other discussion, motion to adjourn by Yungbluth second by Gebhart at 12:30 p.m. All voting aye. Motion carried.
